September 30, 1950 – Impact Aid Law



Did you know???

Impact Aid was two laws enacted a week apart

- P.L. 81-815 provided financial assistance for the **construction** of schools in federally impacted areas
- P.L. 81-874 authorized funding toward the **operating costs** of schools burdened with increased attendance as the result of federal activities and/or deprived of local revenue because of tax exempt status of federal property.

Did you know???

Originally, only civilian students were eligible

- 1951 – Civilians
- 1955 – Military on-base
- 1957 – Military off-base
- 1958 – Indian lands
- 1970 – Low-rent housing

Did you know???

Impact Aid was the vehicle to pass the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965

- In 1994, Impact Aid became a part of ESEA
- Today, it is Title VII

Did you know???

To be eligible for 7002 Federal Property payments, land must have been removed from the tax rolls after 1938

- Why 1938? It's a mystery!
