NAFIS Conference Sponsorship Two National Education Conferences in Washington, DC 350 School District Leaders 30 States

The National Association of Federally Impacted Schools (NAFIS), established in 1973, is a dynamic association of school district leaders that advocates for Impact Aid, a \$1.3 billion Federal education program. More than **350** superintendents, school board members and school business officers from **30** states attend each of NAFIS's two annual conferences in the nation's capital to engage in education policy discussions and to meet with their Congressional delegation.

NAFIS member school districts are demographically and geographically diverse, educating a significant population of military-connected and Native American students. Federally Impacted School districts have in common a loss of local tax revenue caused by a Federal activity, such as Indian Lands, military installations, low rent housing, and national parks because Federal property cannot be taxed. Impact Aid funds reimburse these school districts for the loss of local tax revenue.

The NAFIS Conference Sponsorship offers companies the opportunity to develop meaningful and long term relationships with superintendents, school board members and school business officials from across the country. The sponsorship outlined below provides sponsors with visibility and access to NAFIS members and up-to-date developments in Federal education policy.

NAFIS Conference Sponsorship - March and September Conferences

\$8,000 - two conferences in 12 months/\$4,500 - one conference
