7003 Payment Updates FY 2021

- What is the timeline for final payments for FY 2021?
- Need to complete payment adjustments impacted by FY22 monitoring determinations before doing the final distribution
- The final proration will be close to 100%.

FY 2022 initial payments released

- 50% Proration and \$500 per WSU for CWD
- \$589,980,277 BS paid out
- \$17,312,826 CWD paid out
- 1,034 eligible LEAs for 7003

Impact Aid Coronavirus Relief Act

Number of LEAs taking advantage of the Coronavirus Relief Option

- 128 -7002 LEAs to date (59.5% of applications)
- 684 -7003 LEAs (63% of applications)
- **Late Applications** – late applications will receive a ten percent penalty on all payments arising from the application. Deadline: April 4, 2022 for FY 2023 applicants.

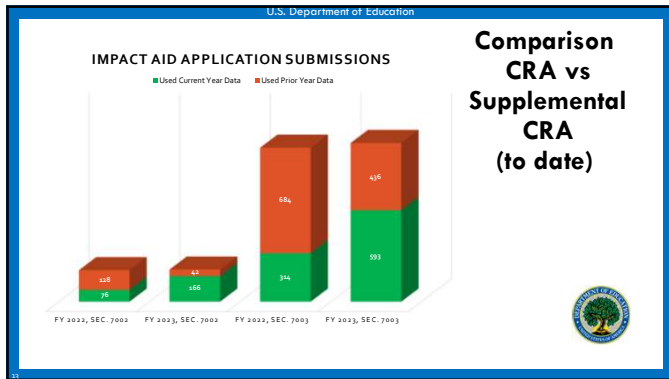

Supplemental Flexibility Act

- Enacted 10 days before the application deadline
- Amendments under Flexibility can be made until June 30
- Section 7003 LEAs who would likely benefit from applying under Flexibility were emailed directly on February 25
- 436 Submitted Applications for 7003 (42% of applications submitted thus far)
- 42 Submitted Applications for 7002 (20% of applications submitted thus far)

FY 2023 Application Monitoring

- 180 Notices emailed on February 23
 - Auto-email from IAGS with a link to a letter and documentation checklist
 - Upload documents to the task in IAGS
 - Deadline: March 31
- Instructions, video training, and live webinar dates posted on IAGS Portal home page <https://impactaid.ed.gov/>

Electronic Data Collection

- 57 total LEAs have entered the pilot program since its inception four years ago.
- LEAs exit the pilot after IAP reviews the survey results. Many have opted to use Coronavirus Relief Act or Supplemental Flexibility Act instead of electronic survey results.
- Six will use the electronic survey results for the first time on the FY 2023 application.
