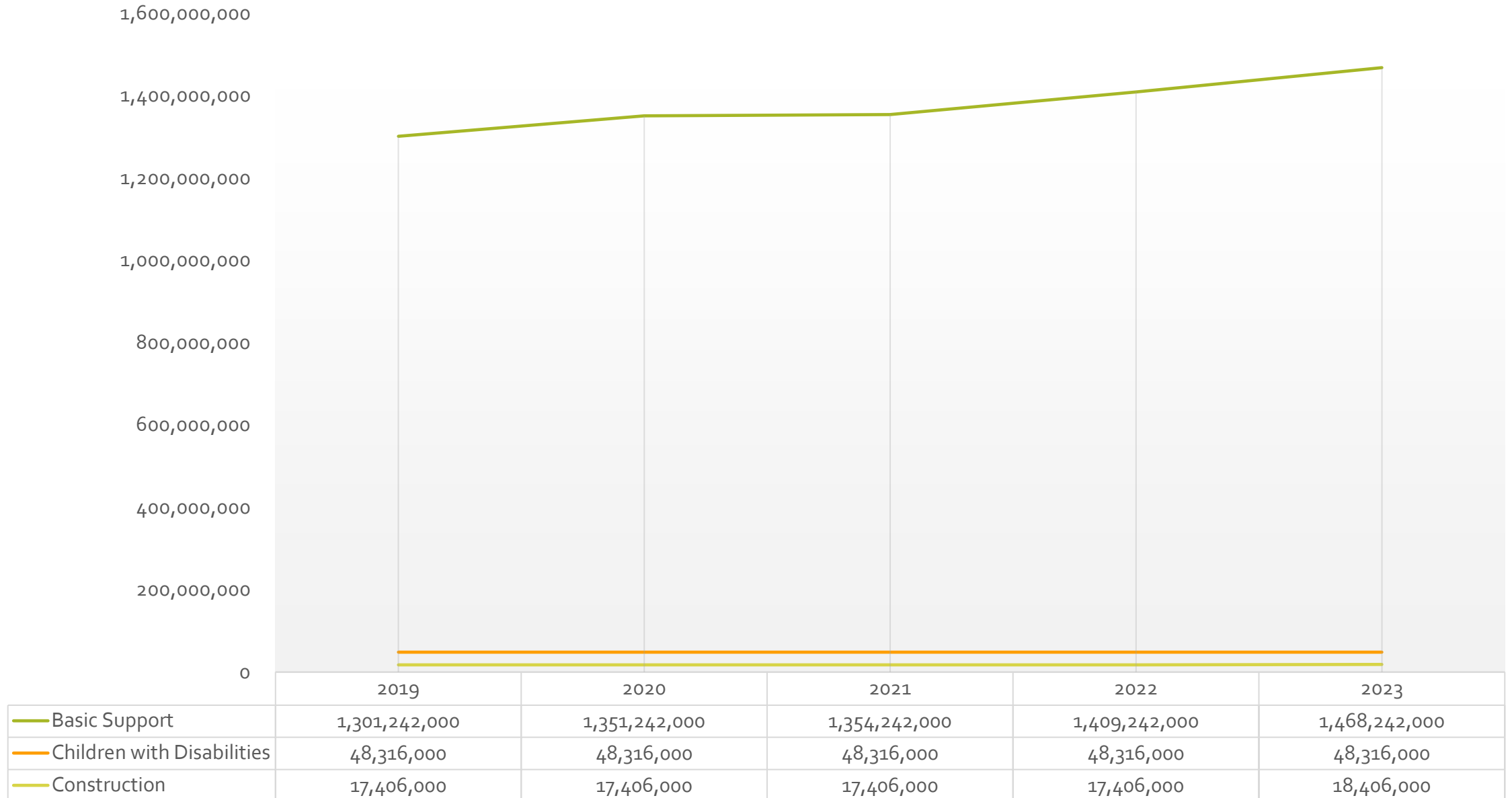

# **7003 Payment Updates FY 2021**

- What is the timeline for final payments for FY 2021?
- Complete: All payment adjustments related to FY 2022 monitoring under the Coronavirus Relief Act
- In Process: Payment adjustments related to FY 2023 monitoring under the Supplemental Flexibility Act for LEAs who used the same survey data for FYs 2021-2023
- The final proration will be close to 100%.
- Expected: TBD



## **7003 Payment Updates FY 2022**

- Current Rates
  - 90% Proration
  - \$1,050 per WSU for CWD
- Heavily Impacted and GCD increases complete
- Final payments will be processed during 2023



## 7002 Payments

### FY 2023 Foundation Payments released

- 197 Eligible Applicants
- \$68.4M paid to date

### FY 2022 Foundation Payments released

- 203 Eligible Applicants
- \$65.8M paid to date

### FY 2021 Remaining Funds Payments

- Must close 7003 first
- Target: TBD





## Reminder: Hold Harmless Mechanics

- LEAs whose final calculated 7003(b) payment is less than 80% of the final amount received in the prior fiscal year are eligible for Hold Harmless funds under Section 7003(e).
- Can only be distributed with final funds
  - Increasing final proration incrementally causes some LEAs to fall out of hold harmless eligibility, making those funds available to distribute, and the rate can be raised again.
  - IAP raises rate until account balance is nearly depleted.
- For FY 2020, 212 LEAs received a 7003(e) payment, totaling \$38.5 million.
  - Mean: \$182 thousand
  - Median: \$23 thousand
  - Range: \$19 to \$13 million

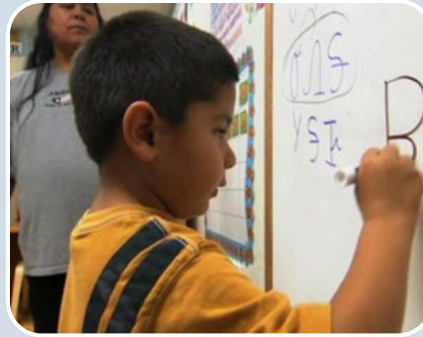
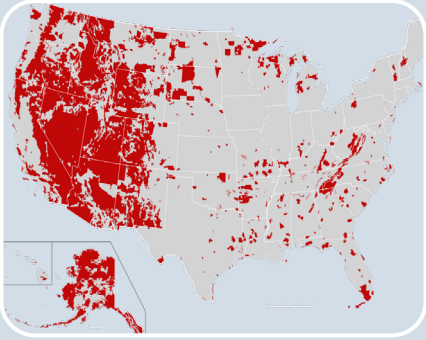
