Overview

About NAFIS

The National Association of Federally Impacted Schools (NAFIS) represents approximately 1,100 Impact Aid-recipient school districts that educate nearly eight million students nationwide. Federally impacted school districts are those located on or near nontaxable Federal property—including military installations; Indian trust, restricted, and Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act lands; Federal low-rent housing facilities; and national parks, national laboratories, and other Federal buildings and property. These school districts, which are demographically and geographically diverse, receive Impact Aid, a Federal education program that reimburses school districts for the lost local revenue and additional costs associated with the presence of Federal property. About This Publication

In this publication, the National Association of Federally Impacted Schools (NAFIS) catalogs how Impact Aid funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 were distributed to federally impacted school districts across the United States and its territories, based on information from the U.S. Department of Education Impact Aid payment database. As of its release in September 2025, FY 2025 is the most recent year for which final payments have been made to federally impacted school districts.

Section 7002 – Federal Property: The report features a list of school districts, by state, that received payments for Section 7002 – Federal Property, as well as their actual payment and the amount they would receive if the program were fully funded. In addition, it lists the number of federally owned and total acres in each school district, as well as the percentage of federal land the district contains. It also notes the congressional district for each school district.

Section 7003 – Basic Support: The report also features a list of school districts, by state, that received payments for Section 7003 – Basic Support, as well as key Impact Aid-related data for each of those districts, including actual and full funding payment amounts; LOT percentage; total student enrollment; total federally connected student enrollment by type; and disability payment. It also notes the congressional district or districts for each school district.

Section 7007 – Construction: The report additionally features a list of school districts, by state, that received payments for Section 7007 – Construction. In FY 2025, funds were distributed as 7007(a) Formula Grants to address school facility construction, renovation, and repair needs.

About Impact Aid

U.S. public school districts are financed through a combination of state and local revenues. Local funding is principally derived from business and residential property taxes, fees, and local sales taxes.

Because Federal land is exempt from taxation (as are many of the businesses and facilities located on it), the land places a financial burden on local school districts and taxpayers.

School districts with Federal property—such as military installations, Indian trust and restricted lands, Federal low-rent housing, national laboratories, national parks and other Federal buildings and lands—lose local revenue because of these non-taxable Federal activities. Impact Aid is a Federal education program that partially reimburses federally impacted school districts—those located on or near Federal property—for this loss of locally-derived revenue. It ensures these districts are not at a financial disadvantage and that the students they serve have access to the opportunities they need to meet their full potential.

Impact Aid funding is direct, locally controlled, and flexible. It goes straight to school districts, bypassing state involvement, and is used to support all students in the district, just like local tax revenue. It can be used for any general fund purpose, such as instructional materials, teacher salaries, transportation, technology, social-emotional supports, extracurricular activities, and facilities. All decisions on how Impact Aid funds are spent are made locally, allowing great flexibility to ensure funds are targeted wherever needs are greatest.

For FY 2025, Congress appropriated approximately \$1.625 billion for Impact Aid, across five line items:

Section 7002 – Federal Property

Federal Property payments reimburse school districts that have lost significant local revenue due to the Federal ownership of land within school district boundaries. Examples of eligible property include national parks and grasslands, Army Corps of Engineers projects, military testing grounds, national laboratories, Federal dams and reservoirs, and military academies. For FY 2025, Congress appropriated **\$79 million** for **Federal Property** payments. Nationwide, 201 school districts applied and were eligible for this funding, with 57 of these school districts containing 25% or more nontaxable federal land. Their **calculated full funding payments** totaled over **\$1.169 billion**.

A school district must meet two criteria to be eligible for Section 7002:

- The property was acquired by the Federal Government after 1938, AND
- The assessed value of the property when it was acquired by the Federal Government was at least 10 percent of the school district's total assessed value.

This property cannot have been acquired in exchange for other Federal property. In addition, the district must not be substantially compensated by increases in revenues from Federal activities from the property, such as timber or mining fees.

School districts must submit an application to the U.S. Department of Education to be considered for a Section 7002 payment each year. The Federal Government uses a three-step formula to determine the amount of Section 7002 funding that a school district should receive, as well its full funding payment (also know as its maximum payment). This formula was established in 2013 and is considered less subjective and easier to administer than the previous one.

Today, each school district receives a foundation payment based on a percentage of funds that it received under the previous formula. Remaining funds are distributed based on the value of taxable property within school district boundaries and the local tax rate. Because Section 7002 is underfunded, the funding available after foundation payments are made is equally prorated based on each school district's full funding payment as a percentage of the total program cost.

Section 7003 – Basic Support

Basic Support payments reimburse school districts for the loss of tax revenue that occurs when families of students live or work on Federal property. Federally connected students include children of members of the uniformed services, children who reside on Indian lands, children who live in Federal low-rent housing, and children whose parents are civilians working and/or living on other Federal land. There is additional funding dedicated to children of members of the uniformed services or children living on Indian lands who have disabilities. For FY 2025, Congress appropriated **\$1.47 billion** for **Basic Support** and **\$48.32 million** to support **special education services** for military and Indian lands students. In total, 932 school districts are part of the Section 7003 – Basic Support program. Their **calculated need** totaled **\$2.52 billion**.

Section 7003 is the largest component of the Impact Aid program in regards to both funding and the number of school districts served. To be eligible, a school district must educate at least 400 federally connected students in its average daily attendance (ADA), or those students must comprise at least three percent of its ADA.

The Federal Government uses a formula to determine the amount of Section 7003 funding that a school district should receive—its full funding payment, also known as its maximum payment. Recognizing that there is varying tax loss associated with where a federally connected student lives, this formula assigns different weights for different categories of students: Indian lands, military on-base, military off-base, low-rent housing, civilian parent living *and* working on Federal land, and civilian parent living *or* working on Federal land.

Impact Aid has not been fully funded since 1969, which means school districts do not receive their full funding payments. To distribute the available funds by need, Congress developed a formula known as the Learning Opportunity Threshold (LOT), which measures how dependent a school district is on Impact Aid. Each district has a LOT percentage determined by the percent of Federal students in its ADA and the percent that the maximum Impact Aid payment is of the district's total current expenditures (TCE). The higher that percentage, the more of its full funding payment a district receives.

Section 7007 – Construction

The Impact Aid Construction program includes both formula grants and competitive grants. In the law, program funds are split into two pots: 40% is allocated by formula, and 60% is dedicated to competitive grants that typically assist districts with emergency facility needs. In recent years, funding has been so low that Congress has instead allocated the full funding to competitive and formula grants in alternating years, distributing formula grants in even fiscal years and awarding discretionary grants in odd fiscal years, rather than maintaining a 40/60 split. For FY 2025, Congress appropriated \$19 million for Construction payments. Nationwide, 166 school districts were eligible for this funding.

Unlike most Impact Aid, which can be used for any general fund purpose, construction funds are restricted to use on construction projects, such as the preparation of drawings and specifications for school facilities; the construction, repair, modernization, and expansion of these facilities; and debt service for such activities.

Section 7007(a) - Construction Formula Grants: School construction formula funding is automatically allocated to eligible districts based on their Section 7003 applications. School districts do not need to apply separately for these funds. There is no time limit during which the funds must be expended - they may be saved for a future project.

- Eligibility – School districts are eligible for formula funds if they receive funds under 7003 and meet at least one of the following conditions:
 - Serve 50 percent or more Indian Lands students
 - Serve 50 percent or more military students
 - Receive funds from 7003(b)(2) (heavily impacted)

Section 7007(b) - Discretionary Construction Grants: For competitive grants, applications are prioritized based on a district's ability to generate local funding (such as through bonding or state funding) and if it has a school facility emergency as determined by the Secretary of Education. "Emergency Request" grants that pose threats to the health, safety and well-being of students are given first priority. "Modernization" grants to address capacity issues and allow the school district to utilize technology and offer a curriculum in accordance with contemporary State standards would also be awarded if funds are available after all emergency grants have been made, but that has not been the case in recent years.

- Eligibility – Any school district that is at least 40 percent impacted with Indian Lands or military dependent students may apply on behalf of the local educational agency. In addition, an individual school site may also apply if the enrollment of either Indian Lands or military dependent students equals or exceeds 40 percent of the school's total enrollment.
- Matching Requirements – The Federal contribution for both emergency and modernization grants cannot exceed 50 percent of the cost of the project, nor can it be more than \$4,000,000 during any four-year period (note: this requirement does not apply to a district that does not have the authority to tax or issue bonds).

Percent Federal: Percent of a school district's total acres that is eligible federal land

School District: Used here to mean local educational agency (LEA) – a board of education or other legally constituted local school authority having administrative control and direction of free public education in a county, township, ISD or other school district, including any state agency that operates and maintains facilities for providing a free public education

Total ADA: Total average daily attendance – the average number of students present (as opposed to enrolled) during the time a school district is in session

Total Federal ADA: Average number of federally connected students present (as opposed to enrolled) during the time a school district is in session

Total Acres: Total acres in a school district
